- **Community Capacity Building:** Strengthened partnerships with key neighborhood organizations to address contextual factors identified in the Martindale-Brightwood *Quality of Life Plan*.
- Capital Improvements at Legacy High: Enhancements to instructional spaces and communityuse areas to deepen both the student and neighborhood experience.

These efforts are designed to sustain and expand what is working, strengthen organizational capacity, and ensure that every student has access to high-quality learning environments and robust postsecondary pathways.

"This historic investment from Lilly Endowment will have a lasting impact on the students and families we serve," said David Spencer, Executive Director of KIPP Indy. "It enables us to expand programs that are already showing strong results while building the long-term infrastructure needed to reach our goal of being in the top quartile of public schools by 2028.
