By the Numbers: Where We Are

Targeted McKinney-Vento Outreach

- 198 families sent a Housing Questionnaire
- 197 Housing Questionnaires completed
- 1 pending completion

Current MKV Enrollment by School

- Unite K–2: 37 students
- Unite 3–5: 42 students
- KICP: 39 students
- Legacy High School: 45 students

Overall McKinney-Vento attendance across KIPP Indy is **87.4%**, exceeding the network goal of **86.5%**. Attendance remains strong at Unite K–2, Unite 3–5 down a few points from last week. Legacy High School is still showing minimal ADA difference between MKV and non-MKV students.

The data shows the primary area still needing additional focus is KICP, where MKV ADA (**85.3%**) is slightly below goal and the gap is more noticeable. This reinforces the need for consistent follow-up and support during periods of transition at the middle school level. I will conduct a weekly McKinney-Vento attendance review for KICP every Wednesday, followed by standing outreach with families to check in, identify barriers, and provide support as needed.

Reminders

Eligibility

McKinney-Vento eligibility is based on whether a student lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes doubled-up housing, temporary shelter, hotel or motel placement, or unsheltered living due to economic hardship.

Please continue to refer students when there is uncertainty. Services are not guaranteed until eligibility is determined through the Housing Questionnaire process.

Transportation

Car services (EverDriven and HopSkipDrive) are provided only for eligible students who reside outside district boundaries and are limited to school and approved after-school activities ending by 6:00 PM.

Missed rides are billed. After three no-shows, service is suspended for 30 days, and alternate transportation options are provided.
